

Mayville State University Intramural Sports Handbook

Accident Policy

MaSU does not carry insurance policy for injuries. All participants are urged to obtain a medical examination prior to participating in any activity. All accidents and injuries must be reported to the intramural coordinator on duty. An accident report form must be completed and signed.

Eligibility Exceptions & Restrictions

Any students, staff, or faculty is allowed to participate in intramural sports with the following exceptions and restrictions:

- A current MaSU ID is required at all events. Participants unable to present a current ID will not be allowed to play until the ID is shown.
- Tri- college students are not allowed to participate in MaSU intramural sporting events.
- An individual may participate in only one team per sport. The team which they first represent will be the only team they may play on for the duration of the intramural sport.
- Any team that allows an ineligible player to play will forfeit that game, even if found out post game.
- Any player transferring from one team to another shall be ineligible to play for that sport for the remainder of the season.
- If a team fields a player who is no longer a MaSU student, the team will forfeit the game and will thus be ineligible for the duration of the season.
- A participant is not eligible to compete in an intramural sport event unless all pertinent information is provided on the appropriate entry form and team roster.
- Ejected players are suspended from all intramural activities until reinstated by the Director of Student Involvement.

Penalties

Any team playing with a player under another teammate's name will be charged with a "loss" for that game. The player will be ineligible to participate in the

remainder of the Intramural league, and the team playing this individual will also be ineligible for the league and post-season tournament.

Forfeits & Game Reporting

All games shall be played on the date and time as scheduled. A five minute grace period is allowed for all sports. After that time, the game will be forfeited. Games lost by forfeit shall not be rescheduled for any reason. A team with two forfeits will be dropped from that sport for the tournaments. Captains are urged to notify the Director of Student Involvement if their team is unable to make a scheduled game.

Sport Specific Regulations

Touch Football

- Teams are Co-Ed.
- Players who are currently listed on the Mayville State University Football Roster as an active player are not permitted to play.
- Red-shirt athletes and full time students can partake in touch football.
- Players who have previously played for the Mayville State University Football program are also permitted to play as long as they are still a student at MaSU.
- Teams will field a minimum of 7 players. Min: 7 players, Max: 10 players.
- More rules and guidelines will be outlined at the Captain Meeting prior to the beginning of the season.

Volleyball

- Teams are Co-Ed.
- Players who are currently listed on the Mayville State University Volleyball roster as an active player are not permitted to play.
- Red-shirt athletes and full time students can partake in Intramural Volleyball.
- Players who have previously played for the Mayville State University Volleyball program are also permitted to play as long as they are still a student at MaSU.

- Teams are only allowed 2 players on each team who have collegiate playing experience (2 redshirts, 2 ex-players, students who have transferred but played at another school).
- Teams will field a minimum of 6 players. Min: 6 players, Max: 10 players.
- More rules and guidelines will be outlined at the Captain Meeting prior to the beginning of the season.

Basketball

- Teams are Co-Ed.
- Players who are currently listed on the Mayville State University Basketball Rosters as an active player are not permitted to play.
- Red-shirt athletes and full time students can partake in Intramural Basketball.
- Players who have previously played for the Mayville State University Basketball program are also permitted to play as long as they are still a student at MaSU.
- Teams are only allowed 2 players on each team who have collegiate playing experience (2 redshirts, 2 ex-players, students who have transferred but played at another school: NJCAA, NCCAA, NCAA, NAIA).
- Teams will field a minimum of 5 players. Min: 5 players, Max: 10 players.
- More rules and guidelines will be outlined at the Captain Meeting prior to the beginning of the season.

Dodgeball

- Teams are Co-Ed.
- Teams will field 6 players but can have 2 substitutes. Min: 6 players, Max: 8 players.
- More rules and guidelines will be outlined at the Captain Meeting prior to the beginning of the season.
