

Student Retention Committee

Purpose:

The Student Retention Committee develops and leads retention efforts that support strategic institutional goals related to undergraduate and graduate student persistence and completion. The committee works in concert with the offices of the Vice President of Academic Affairs, the Dean of Student Affairs, and the Athletic Director as well as departments and committees across the university. The committee advises the President's Cabinet regarding initiatives that support strategic institutional retention and completion goals.

Membership:

The Student Retention Committee members are the Vice President for Academic Affairs, Dean of Student Affairs, Athletic Director, and representatives from Academic Advising, Career Services, Counseling Services, Institutional Effectiveness, Residence Life, Seminar on Success, Student Activities, Student Success, and one at-large faculty member.

In addition, other staff and faculty may be active participants in sub-committees and identified task forces that the main committee will decide to convene as needed. Members of these sub-committees and respective task forces will include individuals who have expertise and interest in specific strategies related to retention and completion.

Meetings:

At least twice each semester and as needed. Sub-committees and task force groups meet as needed.
