The Bachelor of University Studies (B.U.S.) online or on-campus degree program is intended for transfer students who have completed previous coursework at a two-or four-year college or university. The B.U.S. degree provides flexibility for students who wish to determine the content of their degree rather than pursue a specific major. Each student will design a program leading to specific educational goals, but not necessarily within any one department. This provides a flexible and adaptable degree based on your individual needs and previously completed coursework.

The Program

This flexible degree is available to students who wish to structure their own program of study while selecting classes that are valuable for their personal goals. This degree could be the right fit for you if you are not sure which program of study you prefer.

The online B.U.S. program allows you to draw from a number of different online coursework options; including business and accounting; early childhood; education; special education; mathematics and sciences; library media and information science; sociology and psychology; and health, physical education, and recreation.

Students should note that the B.U.S. degree does not qualify the graduate for teacher certification. Students who previously attended college and did not earn a degree for whatever reason will find this program allows them to return and complete their education. The Bachelor of University Studies program at MSU is very **transfer-friendly**, **especially for adult and online learners**.

Your transfer credits do not expire! Any coursework previously earned from regionally accredited institutions will be accepted and applied to the B.U.S. core requirements, essential studies, optional minor, and electives as appropriate, regardless of the academic program in which the student was previously enrolled. Bachelor of University Studies

The Bachelor of University Studies (B.U.S.) degree is available to students who wish to structure their own program of study while selecting classes that are valuable for their personal goals. Students pursuing this degree must complete the essential studies requirements, residency requirements (30 S.H. required from Mayville State University), and academic requirements of the University. Students with, the assistance of their academic advisor, create a program of study. A minimum of 120 semester hours is required.

Upper Division (300-400 level) Core Requirements:

36 upper division semester hours from a 4-year institution. Essential Studies - 36 semester hours Optional Minor - 16-24 semester hours Electives - 24-32 semester hours (without minor 48 SH) Total for B.U.S. degree - 120 semester hours required

At least 36 semester hours of upper-division courses (300-400 level) from a four-year institution are required. All degree requirements must be met, including a minimum grade point average of 2.00 in all areas; overall and essential studies.

Students interested in the University Studies degree should develop an outline for a program of study with their academic advisor.
