

Learner Accessibility Committee

Purpose:

The Learner Accessibility Committee (LAC) creates an infrastructure of policies and procedures to meet learner accessibility needs by developing, continuously examining and improving guiding principles for compliance with accessibility laws (i.e. Section 508 of the ADA) and accessibility of academic resources. LAC recommends processes, including faculty and staff training and necessary personnel, to ensure ongoing institutional compliance with accessibility regulations and guidelines.

Membership:

This committee reports to the Vice President for Academic Affairs and is chaired by a member of the committee chosen by its membership. LAC membership also includes the Director of Student Success and Disability Services, the Director of Human Resources, the Director of Extended Learning, the Distance Programs Support Specialist and two representatives of Faculty Association.

Meetings:

The LAC shall meet a minimum of one time per semester; including summers.
