Contest Guidelines

- Posters must be on 11 X 17 plain or colored paper
- One entry per person
- All Mayville State University Students are encouraged to enter.
- A completed entry form must accompany submissions and be legible (See second page)
- Artists may use photography, paint, marker, pencil, or computer graphics
- No collages, wood, plastic, glass, or metal
- No copyrighted characters, photographs and magazine or newspaper illustrations
- All entries must include a written word component
- Poster must be submitted flat, not rolled up
- Poster must not be laminated
- Posters become the property of ODI
- Submissions not meeting the above guidelines will be disqualified

Judging Criteria

- Each entry will be judged on the following criteria:
- **Originality** of the poster and how the idea is expressed in the design is unique.
- **Artistic Quality**: The artwork and its execution is creative.
- **Visual Impact**: The artwork is impactful and its composition is balanced.
- **Impact of Written Word**: The words used are relevant and reflect the legacy of MLK.

The judges' decisions are final
