Note on Transferred Courses: *Northland Community and Technical College courses that satisfy expectations of course content for the specific MaSU 300-level courses indicated will transfer for those MaSU courses as non-upper division credit towards the total of 120 semester credits required for graduation. The 200-level transfer courses cannot count as true 300-level courses towards the 30-semester credit upper division courses requirement for a bachelor's degree.*

*American Sign Language (ASL) courses are offered through Lake Region State College.

**Other languages of study from regionally-accredited institutions may be used in substitute for the language requirement. Mayville State University offers Spanish.

***Students transferring in either of these course will also have met the essential studies requirement of CIS 175.
