The Program

The program provides the foundational coursework necessary for students who are preparing for careers in accounting, finance, auditing and related fields, or who plan to take professional accounting certification exams.

The accounting program has been designed to prepare students for CPA licensure exams in North Dakota. Completion of the program does not award students the CPA designation. North Dakota law requires that individuals who sit for the Certified Public Accountant (CPA) professional exam must complete 150 semester credits of college education.

On-campus and online/distance students living in or moving to any state other than North Dakota should be aware of the unique CPA licensure requirements for that location. Program applicants seeking to establish CPA licensure outside the state of North Dakota need to contact the Accounting Program Coordinator Dustin Olson, 701-788-4790 or dustin.olson3@mayvillestate.edu or division chair prior to beginning any on-campus or online/distance academic program which would lead to licensure. It is important for all students to understand the licensure requirements for the location they intend to live and work.

Students completing the B.S. in Accounting program must complete 36 credits of Essential Studies courses. The following Essential Studies courses are required as prerequisite courses for the program: COMM 110; ENGL 110; ENGL 120 or ENGL 125 (preferred); MATH 103 (College Algebra – may substitute a higher-level Math course with approval); ECON 201; and, ECON 202.
