










So if a student goes into "manage classes:"




• The Manage Classes page is where students can drop and add a class, and other things.

Academic Charges are added to a student's bill when they register for class(es).

There is a <u>very long document</u> I've provided that includes this statement: your student's housing/dining charges will appear on the campus connection account on or just before August 1.

Payment is due <u>September 9, 2020</u>. Financial Aid will pay just before that date, and you will already know ahead of time how much you or your student will need to pay.

Authorized Users

To set up an Authorized User:


