

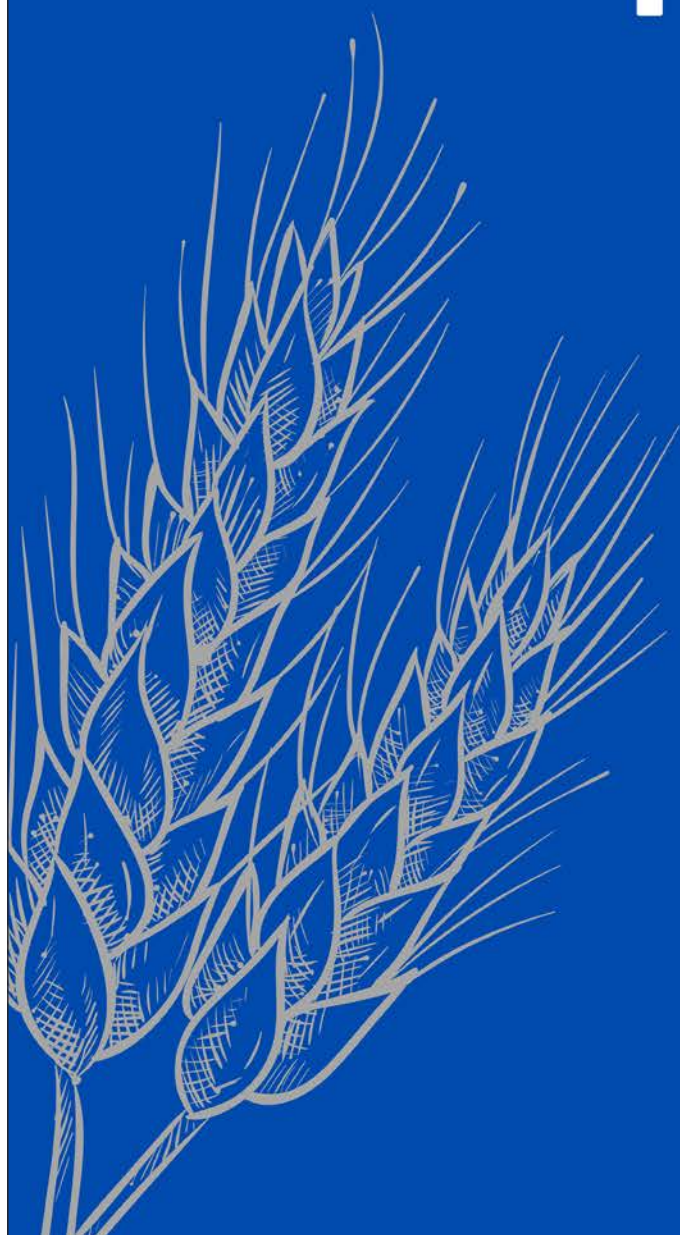

A PIVOTAL ERA OF TRANSFORMATION

Making an impact

Amid a period of remarkable transformation, Mayville State University is experiencing a true renaissance. With renewed energy across academics, campus life, and community engagement, the university is making bold strides in excellence with the important goal of impacting the workforce needs of North Dakota. Strategic investments in facilities, personnel, and student success are yielding tangible results, while a revitalized sense of purpose is inspiring alumni and partners alike. This era of progress reflects a deep commitment to honoring tradition while embracing the future.

A New Old Main

During the 2023 legislative session, Mayville State was extremely fortunate to be granted \$52,254,901 in state funding for the renovation of the flagship campus building, Old Main. The renovation of Old Main is transformational, not only for the building, but also for the entire university, community, and region. In the renovation, the exterior of the building will maintain its beloved historic charm, while the interior will be completely remodeled to provide optimal learning space that appeals to the students of today and the future.

Student Growth & Success

The good news of what is happening at Mayville State is reaching beyond the campus and attracting students. During the last eight years, Mayville State has achieved success in enrollment. This fall, headcount AND FTE are the highest in the history of the institution.

- Fall 2025 headcount is 1,215, a 7.14% increase over Fall 2024. Full-time equivalent (FTE) of 857 is a 7.93% increase over Fall 2024. The number of freshmen enrolled this fall increased by 43.7% over Fall 2024.
- A record number of students who are N.D. residents are enrolled this fall.
- In academic year 2018, Mayville State graduated 163 students. That number has grown to 250 graduates in academic year 2025.
- Mayville State recently recorded an 81% student retention rate, an all-time record for the institution and an increase of 14% over Fall 2023.

✓ New Academic Programs

New programs that address workforce needs have been added. These include Criminal Justice and Agribusiness. A new leadership track has been added in Business Administration. The Nursing Informatics Certificate addresses the need for data analysis for health outcomes.

✓ Financial Health

MSU's CFI index skyrocketed from 0.4 in 2020 to 7.9 on June 30, 2024.

✓ Fundraising Success

MSU Foundation total assets have grown from \$8,383,419 on June 30, 2017 to \$20,600,553 as of June 30, 2025. This growth has been aided by the N.D. Challenge Grant Program. Donors have been motivated by the incentive of a 50% match provided by the state for gifts to scholarships.

✓ Scholarships

Mayville State offers a high-quality education enhanced with legendary personal service, all for an affordable cost. Scholarships give the needed extra needed boost. In 2020-21, a total of \$299,785 in scholarship funding was available. That amount grew to \$805,610 for 2026-27. Scholarship assistance goes hand-in-hand with enrollment growth and retention.

✓ Campus Facility Improvements

In addition to making improvements that are not visible, like replacing pipes, boilers, and roofs, more visible items include a remodel of the Campus Center, creating lovely bookstore, lounge and mailroom space. An elevator has been installed as well. The Alumni Association spearheaded the establishment of Legacy Plaza along a major corridor connecting the east and west areas of the campus. Alumni and friends generously supported the project financially. A new paved parking lot is providing important accommodations on the east side of campus.

Registration

All individuals should register at the cashier's desk upon
arrival. A bidding number will be assigned and final
instructions will be shared at that time.

Silent Auction

Each item has its own bidding sheet. When bidding on silent
auction items, place your bidding number, your last name, and
the amount of your bid in the appropriate columns. You may
raise your bid as often as you wish, until the closing time is
announced. All silent auction items have a minimum bid-raise
amount noted on the top of the bid sheet. Bids that don't
follow the minimum bid-raise guideline will be disqualified.
Silent bids may not be withdrawn once submitted.
High bidders may pick up their items after they have paid for
them at the cashier's desk.

Live Auction

The auctioneer conducts the live auction and has the final
word on an auctioned item. Hold your bidding number up high
when you wish to bid on a live-auction item.

Sales and Certificates

Please read your catalog, vouchers, and certificates carefully!
All trips, items, and services must be used during the
designated dates and within guidelines. In the case of dinners
by private individuals, arrangements must be made so the
times will be convenient for both the donor and the auction-
item winner. These items must be used within one year of the
auction, unless otherwise designated. Some auction items are

be presented to the donor to redeem the services or products.
