Mayville State University Student Right-to-Know – Equity in Athletics

Mayville State University has documented calculation rates of students who participate in intercollegiate athletics and determined the financial support provided to make and female teams for operating expenses and athletically related aid. The most recent report is summarized below for the 2024-25 school year. In the fall of 2024, there were 211 full-time male, and 64 full-time female students enrolled at Mayville State. The average institutional coaching salaries of head coaches for male sports was \$28,170, while head coaches for female sports averaged \$25,184. It is important to note that all head coaches had other duties at the institution. Therefore, average annual salaries per Full Time Equivalent (FTE) coach were \$59,618 for male sports and \$54,747 for female sports. Average coaching salaries for part-time assistant coaches was \$19,225 for male sports, and \$19,416 for female sports, while FTE salaries were \$29,872 for men's teams and \$24,999 for women's teams.
