## PROGRESS UPDATES

- **Basement:** Drywall finishing and painting in progress.
- **First floor:** Installing final overhead devices and flooring.
- **Second floor:** Installing ceiling cloud devices and preparing for construction cleaning in the coming weeks.
- **Third floor:** Final site concrete preparation has begun.
- **Fourth floor:** Final site concrete preparation has begun.
- **Exterior:** Final site concrete preparation has begun. Crews are completing touch-ups on brick, coatings, and metal panels.
