DAY 1 FRIDAY, JULY 20, 2018

Fargo / Grand Forks / Mpls-St. Paul – Vancouver, BC: Depart the US on your international flight to Vancouver, British Columbia in Canada. See invoice and information regarding your confirmed departure city. Transfer to Hotel Blu Vancouver for overnight.

DAY 2 SATURDAY, JULY 21, 2018

Vancouver – Embarkation: Breakfast at hotel. Morning sightseeing tour of Vancouver includes Vancouver’s Gastown district, a refreshing mix of old and new with cobbled streets, quaint courtyards and Victorian-style buildings. The district was named after gold prospector and riverboat captain John “Gassy Jack” Deighton, named for his “hot air” and tall tales. No tour of Vancouver would be complete without viewing world-famous Stanley Park. One of the largest urban parks in Canada, this spectacular spot in the heart of the city is actually a rainforest, teeming with wildlife, magnificent trees and fragrant blossoms. Within the Park are the West Coast Native Totem Poles, elaborately decorated with symbolic images and faces. After the tour, transfer to the pier for embarkation aboard the Star Princess, your home for the next 7 days. Depart Vancouver at 4:30pm and begin your journey along the Alaskan coastline. DAY 3 SUNDAY, JULY 22, 2018

DAY 5 TUESDAY, JULY 24, 2018

Juneau: In 1880, it was slow going for Joe Juneau and Richard Harris as they searched for gold with the help of Native guides. After climbing mountains, forging streams and facing countless difficulties, they found nuggets “as large as beans.” From their discovery came three of the largest gold mines in the world. By the end of World War II, more than \$150 million in gold had been mined. Eventually the mines closed, but the town Joe Juneau founded became the capital of Alaska and the business of gold was replaced by the business of government. Today Juneau is famous not only for gold and government but also for its breathtakingly beautiful glaciers and stunning views of both water and mountains. DAY 6 WEDNESDAY, JULY 25, 2018

Skagway: Skagway was the gateway to the gold fields for the thousands who flocked to Alaska and the Yukon with the hope of striking it rich. Today, Skagway has less than 1,000 residents, but it still retains the flavor of the gold rush era. Choose from a variety of shore excursions or explore on your own. Overnight in selected cabin category.



DAY 7 THURSDAY, JULY 26, 2018

Scenic Cruising – Glacier Bay National Park: Just west of Juneau, Glacier Bay National Park boasts some of the world’s most spectacular tidewater glaciers, such as Margerie Glacier, which often drops colossal chunks of ice into the sea. Not surprisingly, Glacier Bay National Park and its epic ice giants are part of a UNESCO World Heritage Site comprising Alaska’s magnificent park system. During your scenic cruise, friendly Park Rangers will join the ship to share their knowledge of this amazing place and host a fun Junior Ranger program for kids. They may even be able to help you identify Glacier Bay’s abundant wildlife, including humpback whales, sea otters, porpoises, harbor seals, black bears, mountain goats, bald eagles and large colonies of seabirds. Take in the awe-inspiring scenery as you enjoy an unforgettable day of sailing through this dazzling park, where you’ll glide along emerald waters and past calving icebergs, and can breathe in the crisp, fresh air to your heart’s content. DAY 8 FRIDAY, JULY 27, 2018

Scenic Cruising – College Fjord: Discovered in the northwest corner of Prince William Sound during an 1899 research expedition, spectacular College Fjord and its glaciers were named after prestigious east coast schools by the college professors who first laid eyes upon their majesty. Stretching for miles, these massive rivers of ice tumble down from mountains and through valleys, dipping into the pristine waters of the fjord. There you’ll have a chance to watch the awe-inspiring process of glaciers calving, or dropping enormous pillars of ice into the sea, as they crack and land with a thunderous splash - a once-in-a-lifetime experience not to be missed! During the summer, it’s not unheard of to catch a glimpse of one of the area’s 40-ton humpback whales feeding in the waters of the fjord. up the evening sun with a pint of locally brewed beer or a glass of wine (at your own expense). Get great tips from our grill masters who cook our wild Alaskan salmon perfectly over a bed of black spruce coals. After your meal, catch the musical comedy at the Palace Theatre, which is just a short walk from the Salmon Bake. If you only see one show in Alaska make sure it's the "Golden Heart Revue." 

WAIVER OF PRE-EXISTING CONDITIONS

The Pre-Existing Condition Exclusion is waived provided the insured traveler has paid his/her premium within 14 days of deposit.

DEFINITIONS & DETAILS

Now that you have arranged your trip, we feel that it is our responsibility to recommend travel insurance to protect your investment. Please read the information below to make an informed decision concerning this matter.

NOTE: The insurance company requires a minimum of 10 participants to be eligible for this group offer. If numbers are not met, price may increase or if you do not accept the increase, a refund will be granted.

Although insurance can be taken out at any time prior to final payment, we urge you to act immediately to receive the benefits outlined. Please note, however, that the policy exclusion for pre-existing conditions is waived provided the insured traveler has paid his/her premium within 14 days of deposit.

Group Travel Insurance is only available for US citizens. If you live outside the United States, please contact our office for additional insurance options. Individuals who are not on an escorted tour, but traveling independently should request a separate brochure with rates for individual travelers. If you wish to receive a quote for additional coverage beyond \$7000, please indicate total coverage amount on tour application.

Trip Cancellation: Protects your prepaid travel arrangements up to \$25,000 for your trip in the event you have to cancel your trip due to covered reasons such as a sickness, injury, terrorist incident, theft of passports or job termination, just to name a few.

Trip Interruption: Reimburses for the unused, non-refundable portion of your trip and for the increased transportation costs it takes for you to return home or to continue your trip due to a covered reason. Maximum coverage: \$37,500.

Missed Connections: Reimburses for covered expenses resulting from a covered delay that causes you to miss your scheduled flight or cruise.

Travel Delay: Receive up to \$150 per day per person to cover additional accommodation/travel expenses or lost prepaid expenses due to a departure delay of six or more hours.

Emergency Medical Transportation: Provides medically necessary transportation to the nearest appropriate facility following a covered illness or injury. Also covers the cost of your transportation back home following a covered illness or injury.

Emergency Medical and Dental: This secondary coverage provides reimbursement for expenses incurred during your trip due to covered medical and dental emergencies. \$50 deductible. \$500 maximum for emergency dental care.

Baggage Loss / Damage: Covers loss, damage or theft of baggage and personal effects.

RESERVATIONS & PAYMENT

To make reservations, complete application form and send deposit of \$1000 per person to address shown on application form or register at www.BrekkeTours.com. The final balance is due on April 16, 2018. For RESERVATIONS or final payment made within 21 days prior to departure, there is a \$50 per reservation handling/express fee. Checks, Money Orders, VISA and MasterCard are accepted as forms of payment. In case of billing error, we reserve the right to re-invoice with correct pricing.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

It is the responsibility of each passenger to obtain proper travel documents, such as passport and visa. Each passenger must be in possession of a passport with a validity of at least six (6) months beyond the conclusion of their trip. Passenger is responsible for obtaining a visa where applicable. For entry regulations to your destination, please visit http://travel.state.gov/travel/cis_pa_tw/cis/cis_1765.html.

It is imperative that your airline ticket matches your first and last name exactly as it reads on your passport. Any changes to your air booking, which include spelling, are subject to a change fee, penalties, or cancellation.

With full payment, tour documents are normally sent 14-21 days prior to departure and should arrive within 6 business days. If you request documents earlier, and if it is possible to accommodate you, there is a \$50 per reservation handling/ express fee.

CANCELLATIONS

In addition to a \$100 administration fee, the following per person cancellation fee applies:

- 90 days or more before departure: none
- 89—57 days before departure: amount of deposit
- 56—29 days before departure: 50% of total charges
- 28—15 days before departure: 75% of total charges
- within 14 days before departure: 100% of total charges

Cancellation fees may also apply to any additional services, including accommodations, independently supplied services, and optional excursions reserved prior to, during and after the tour. Cancellations must be in writing. A change of itinerary or traveler name (substitution) after receipt of deposit will be treated as a cancellation and new reservation; standard cancellation fees apply. Trip cancellation insurance is strongly recommended.

INSURANCE

The client is urged to protect his/her investment with travel insurance. Generally pre-existing conditions can be covered if premium payment is made within 14 days of your initial trip deposit. Brekke Tours is not responsible for loss, damage or theft of luggage or personal belongings, or for personal injury, accident or illness.

CRUISE COSTS

All rates are based on tariffs in effect at the time the tour was planned and are subject to increase in the event of changes in taxes/fees.

AIR TRANSPORTATION

Air & Land Price is based on scheduled transportation in economy class and nonrefundable airfare on one of our preferred airline partners (if requesting a specific carrier, an additional charge may apply) from the city specified in the itinerary. The tour package price reflects airfare currently in effect & is subject to change until ticketed. Inquire about airfare options from your home city. Passengers coming from different cities, booked or deposited at different times, may be booked on alternate routings/different flights. Passengers are responsible for charges due to delays on domestic flights (purchased as separate tickets) in connection with an international flight.

NOTE:

- If using frequent flyer miles, participants must book directly with the carrier.
- Purchase of a domestic ticket to connect with international flight or purchase of a land only package:
 - If booking a domestic flight to connect with the trans-Atlantic flight, an overnight (at least for eastbound travel) or an early flight (with at least one backup flight available) is recommended.
 - Carriers will not necessarily allow passengers to check bags through to the final destination with multiple tickets. Thus passengers will only be able to check the bag to the destination on the first ticket(s). The passenger must collect the baggage at baggage claim for their first ticketed destination, and then re-check

their baggage with the down-line carrier for the next flight. Various baggage restrictions may also apply subject to carrier guidelines.

Brekke Tours is not responsible for:

- any costs/fees relating to airline delays, rescheduling or cancellation. If you miss your departure flight, it is your responsibility to work with the airline on which you are ticketed to reach your destination.
- any additional expenses incurred prior to joining the tour package.
- and will not provide any refund for services or portions of trips missed due to cancelled, rescheduled or delayed flights.

FUEL SURCHARGES AND TAXES

If you choose to purchase airfare through Brekke Tours, final charges for fuel and taxes will be accessed in your statement prior to final payment.

LUGGAGE

Size and weight limitations for carry-on and checked baggage on international flights vary from airline to airline and are subject to change, so please check with your airline before departure. Current restrictions for most international flights are two checked pieces and one carry-on per person, in addition to a purse or briefcase. The overall dimension and weight of each checked piece may not exceed 62 inches (length+width+height) and 50 pounds, while the overall dimension and weight of the carry-on may not exceed 45 inches and 13 pounds. Brekke Tours is not responsible for additional fees imposed by air carriers regarding baggage. Airport portage is not included as security regulations within most airports require that travelers handle and be responsible for their own luggage. HOTELS

Triple rooms are available on request only and no discount applies. A limited number of single rooms are available at the supplementary cost shown. All rooms are assigned by the hotel management upon arrival. Requests for special room assignments should be submitted in writing with final payment, 75 days prior to departure. Special room requests cannot be guaranteed. Not all hotels in Alaska are air-conditioned.

SERVICE CHARGES, TIPS & TAXES

During your cruise, you will meet staff throughout the ship who provide you with excellent service. Many more crew support those who serve you directly.
