




Step by Step	Screen Shots
<p>Turn on the Ally Course Tool.</p> <p>Go to Course Management > Customization > Tool Availability</p>	
<p>Find Z-Tool (the list is alphabetical) and make sure all possible options are checked.</p> <p>Click Submit</p> <p>Note: The Ally tool is temporarily labeled “Z-Tool” until all NDUS institutions have enabled Ally.</p>
