

Online

Through the **completely online course rotation**, you can balance work, family and coursework demands as you complete this degree. While most online classes are asynchronous, which means you are not required to login at designated class times, your online courses are not self-paced. You will complete weekly assignments throughout the semester. You may begin coursework in fall, spring, or summer sessions. Mathematic courses follow a specific rotation however, and not all required courses are offered every semester.

MSU's mathematics program provides you with the knowledge, skills, and techniques that are essential for applying mathematics in non-teaching positions. You'll develop an awareness of the vital connections between mathematical topics and their real world applications. The online, mathematics program is an adult transfer student-oriented program, but freshman students may apply.

Mathematics

This major provides students with the knowledge, skills and techniques needed for using mathematics in non-teaching positions in business or industry. This major consists of 29 semester hours in mathematics, including completion of the final Mathematics Comprehensive (MATH 480).

Students without a previously earned bachelor's degree but with an associate's degree must complete a minor. Students with an earned bachelor's degree are not required to complete a minor. Pre-requisite courses, MATH 165 (Calculus I), COMM 110, ENGL 110, ENGL 120 or ENGL 125 are required as well.
