TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID-19



- If asymptomatic, stay at home at least 10 days from the day of test.
- If symptomatic, stay at home for 10 days from the onset of symptoms and be fever free for at least 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication and show improvement of respiratory symptoms.

IDENTIFIED AS A CLOSE CONTACT



- Once identified as a close contact by the Case's contact tracer, you will be asked to quarantine for 14 days since the date of the last exposure.
- Even if you test negative during the 14 day period you will be asked to continue the quarantine throughout the entire 14 days as symptoms of COVID-19 may develop up to 14 days after exposure.

WAITING FOR TEST RESULTS



- If symptomatic, remain at home until notification of test results.
- If you are asymptomatic and tested at a mass testing event, you do not need to quarantine until test results come back. You may go back to work until results come back.
- If a household contact (significant other, or child) is waiting for test results and they are symptomatic please stay home until results are back.

HAVE SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19



- If at work and you develop symptoms, please put on your mask and go home.
- If you have a fever of 100.4 or develop an onset of or experience worsening of two or more symptoms of COVID-19 please stay home from work. If tested, please remain home until notified of test results. If not tested, please follow the Return to Work Checklist.

RETURN TO WORK CHECKLIST

- YOU MUST BE FEVER FREE FOR AT LEAST 24 HOURS WITHOUT THE USE OF FEVER-REDUCING MEDICATIONS.
- YOU MUST HAVE IMPROVED RESPIRATORY SYMPTOMS.
