Starting off the new year, the Comets head out to Forest City, Iowa to take on the Waldorf Warriors. Mayville ended up with the 63-58 victory with player Jordan Zrust scoring 41 points! Next stop was to play Viterbo University where the ladies had a hard fought battle but ended up coming short 60-72. After this weekend, Jordan Zrust received her 3rd player of the week award. The Friday game of the following weekend against Dakota State was rescheduled but the Saturday game against the Bellevue Bruins was still on. The Comets ended up winning 59-58 in the game against Bellevue in a nail biter. On the 22nd of January, the comets took on our rival Valley City State winning 83-77 and was able to have a home crowd advantage in the win. The following day against the Dicknson State Blue Hawks, we pulled out another win 64-52. Jordan Zrust was named player of the week for the 4th time after this weekend averaging 22 points and 12 rebounds. The comets record moves to 10-2 overall and 5-1 in the conference!
