First-time participants - high school students, transfers from non-NAIA schools, and those who have never participated in athletics at an NAIA member school - must register with the online service.


When you take the ACT or SAT tests, be sure to specify the code **9876** to have your test scores sent directly to the NAIA Eligibility Center.

Room and Board The costs for a double room may vary from \$2,445 in a traditional residence hall to \$3,515 for modern suites. Board plan options are \$1,200/semester, \$1,600/semester, or \$2,250/semester to be used in the cafeteria. The expenses shown above reflect a traditional residence hall selection and the \$1,600/semester plan for dining. Notes These costs are based on current tuition and room/board rates. All costs are subject to change. Mayville State's academic year consists of two semesters. Scholarships, waivers, and financial aid are available for qualified students.

According to information posted to university websites, Mayville State University is priced, on average, \$6,190 per year lower than the larger universities in our region. Among these colleges and universities that claim similar outcomes relative to graduate and professional school admission and job placement, Mayville State provides exceptional academic quality and great value.

On Mayville State's campus, students receive the attention and direction that they expect and deserve from their instructors. There's an instructor for every 13 students on Mayville State's campus. On larger campuses in the region, the student-to-faculty ratio can be as high as 20:1, with lectures on campus holding up to 200 students. At MSU, our classes rarely exceed 40 students. We can provide the personal service our school stands by.

FINANCIAL AID

Financial Aid Budget All students need to anticipate additional personal expenses related to college attendance. These additional expenses include books and supplies for classes and miscellaneous items such as transportation, weekend meals, entertainment, clothing, etc. An estimated total of \$3,100 is budgeted for these expenses; \$1,000 of which is for books and supplies. Personal expenses will vary for each student.

To Pursue Financial Aid at MSU

- 1. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at www.fafsa.gov.
- 2. Be sure to list MSU's federal school code of 002993 on your application.
- 3. Once the application is processed, MSU will receive your FAFSA information and will make every effort to provide adequate financial assistance.

SCHOLARSHIPS

1. Residents of North Dakota and Minnesota are eligible for **Honor and Leadership Scholarships**. These <u>are very limited</u> so send official transcripts and test scores in so an offer can be made. Honor and Leadership Scholarships vary from \$500 to \$2,500 and may be renewable.

Non-Resident Merit Scholarships are awarded to students from other states and provinces and will vary from \$500 to \$2,000 for 2021-22, depending upon the student's state of residence and previous academic performance, and are renewable. These are very limited, so send official transcripts and test scores in at www.mayvillestate.edu/scholarships.

- 2. Endowed MSU Foundation Scholarships: Scholarships designated for specific academic divisions are awarded by that designated division. Scholarship applications received by the February 15 deadline are sent to division chairs for their review and determination. Other scholarship recommendations are made by the Financial Aid Committee.
- **3. Diversity Waivers:** Students are required to apply each year by completing an application available online. Students must have maintained a cumulative institutional grade point average of at least 2.00 to be considered for scholarship or for a renewal. Recipients of diversity waivers may be required to reside in campus residence halls.
- **4. International Student Waivers:** Students are required to apply each year by completing an application available online. Students must have maintained a cumulative institutional grade point average of at least 2.50 to be considered for scholarship or a renewal. Recipients of international student waivers must also reside in campus housing during the terms in which they receive a waiver.
- **5. Participation Scholarships:** Scholarships are available for those students who participate in music and theatre. Participation is the only basis for eligibility.
- **6. Dual Credit Waiver:** This unique waiver program is available only to those students who enrolled in dual credit high school courses offered through Mayville State.
- 7. Nelson Family Endowed Scholarship: The Nelson Family Endowed Scholarship is a scholarship opportunity that is meant to help non-traditional students achieve their goals. The assistance is especially geared toward those individuals who may be changing their paths in life or those pursuing changes in careers. A special emphasis of the scholarship is to promote the concepts of volunteerism, leadership, development and out-of-classroom experiences for the scholarship recipients.

FRESHMAN ADMISSION

Admission requirements - Freshman Students

To be considered for admission, freshman applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Cumulative grade point average of 2.0
- Completion of College Preparatory Core Requirements
 - 4 units of English
 - 3 units of Mathematics (Algebra 1 and above)
 - 3 units of Lab Science
 - · 3 units of Social Studies

Freshman applicants who do not meet the requirements listed above may be evaluated on an individual basis. Applicants may be asked to provide one or more of the following as supplemental requirements:

- ACT or SAT test scores
- · Essay or personal statements

Required Documents - Freshman Students

Freshman applicants will be asked to supply the following documents before they will be reviewed for admission:

- Admissions Application
- High school transcript; official or unofficial
 - · In-progress and complete

Once the transcripts are received, a review and evaluation will begin to determine GPA for acceptance to Mayville State University.

To apply for freshman admission for the upcoming academic year, submit the following:

- A completed **MSU application for admission**. (Complete online at www.MayvilleState.edu)
- A non-refundable, one-time \$35 application fee.
 No admissions decisions are made until the application fee is received.
- An official high school transcript or proof of successful completion of the GED. Ask your high school to send an official transcript. If you completed your GED exam, have the official results sent to MSU. Unofficial transcripts can be attached to applications for freshman only.
- An official transcript showing any and all courses attempted and grades earned from other
- · colleges or universities.
- A completed university immunization form.
 For anyone born after 1956, proof of immunization against measles, mumps, and rubella must be supplied by official documents. Proof of the meningococcal disease (Meningitis) vaccination is required, as well, for students living on campus.

The North Dakota University System has waived

the ACT/SAT text score requirement for admission through the summer session of 2023.

Why is this happening? ACT and SAT have made these decisions in response to the guidelines set forth by the Centers for Disease Control concerning the coronavirus pandemic.

What does this mean? If you intend to enroll at Mayville State University, you will not need to provide ACT or SAT scores as a requirement for admission. If you submit your test scores, they will be used to help determine placement in math and English courses.

Nursing graduate charges are \$548.83 per semester credit.

MSN (Masters of Science in Nursing) - Nurse Educator Track

The Graduate Nurse Educator Track is a 38-credit, online program that prepares the baccalaureate prepared registered nurse for advanced nursing practice as a nurse educator in academic and practice settings. An alternative 15-credit graduate certificate option is also available.

MSN (Master of Science in Nursing) - Leadership & Management Track

The Master of Science in Nursing degree program is a 37-credit, online program that prepares the baccalaureate prepared registered nurse for advanced nursing practice in healthcare leadership and management. An alternative 13-credit graduate certificate option is also available.

*Includes 100-hr, practicum requirement across 10-week block, in an approved academic and/or healthcare setting.

TRANSFER ADMISSION

To be considered for admission, transfer applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Completed 24 or more semester credits (36 or more quarter hours)
- Good Standing (not dismissed or suspended) at their most recent institution
- Cumulative grade point average of 2.0

Transfer applicants who do not meet requirements listed above may be evaluated on an individual basis. Applicants may be asked to provide one or more of the following:

- High school transcript to determine previous academic performance
- ACT or SAT test scores
- Essay or personal statements

Required Documents - Transfer Students

Transfer applicants will be asked to supply the following documents before they will be reviewed for admission:

- Admissions Application
- Transcripts from All previously attended colleges; official or unofficial
 - In-progress and complete

Once **ALL** transcripts are received, a review and evaluation will begin to determine GPA for acceptance to Mayville State University.

Accepting unofficial Transcripts through Summer 2023

Mayville State University, as of February 25, 2021, may be allowed to accept unoffical transcripts to review an applicant's admission status. Unofficial transcripts may be submitted by new incoming freshman and transfer applicants.

Official transcripts are not required for admission decisions, but delay in submitting these documents may have impact on receiving federal financial aid and accurate course evaluations in transfer credit and grade point averages.

Waiving Official Test Scores through Summer 2023

Test scores are not required for admission decisions, but they are used for placement into courses. If you do not have scores to submit, you may be required to take the Accuplacer Test before registering in courses.

GRADUATE ADMISSION CONTINUED

To apply for graduate admission, complete the online Graduate Application for Admission and submit a non-refundable \$35.00 application fee at www.MayvilleState.edu.

Graduate charges are \$440 per semester credit.

Master of Education. Mayville State will begin offering the Master of Education (M.Ed.) in Spring 2022 with the Adult Teaching and Learning track and the Innovative Teaching Practices track. The Master of Education-Special Education track will begin in Fall 2022. For more information, contact the Division of Education at education@mayvillestate.edu.

MAT (Master of Arts in Teaching). The Master of Arts in Teaching degree program is a 32-credit, online program that provides options for graduates with bachelor's degrees to obtain a secondary education professional teaching degree while maintaining employment. The MAT program meets certification requirements of the North Dakota Education Standards and Practices Board (ESPB).

Graduate Certificate in Online Digital Teaching. Mayville State University is pleased to offer a graduate certificate for online instruction. This 10-credit graduate certificate provides educators with focused learning experiences to gain the necessary skills that best support student learning through an online delivery system.
