Admission Procedure – Graduate Degree Applicants

Graduate applications, as defined in SBHE Policy 410 must satisfy the following requirements to be eligible for consideration of admissions:

- 1. Completion of Mayville State University's application for admission and pays the application fee.
- 2. Official college or university transcripts of all previous academic work from each institution attended.
- 3. Validation of baccalaureate degree from a regionally accredited organization or national recognized agency.
- 4. International applicants shall adhere to M402.9.
- 5. Grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
- 6. Mayville State University may require additional extensive application materials.
- 7. Resident quotas may be established for admission purpose in each program at Mayville State University's discretion:
 - a. Minnesota residents must be admitted on the same basis as North Dakota residents or as otherwise permitted under the North Dakota/Minnesota reciprocity agreement, unless the program is exempt from that agreement.
- 8. Mayville State University may require documentation of immunity as defined in M506.
- 9. Mayville State University may limit the number of course(s) and/or credits accepted in transfer credits for each program.
